- **Eye Care Needs:** We are **NOT** currently seeing patients in our offices for routine vision care. If you have an emergency please call the office and you will be directed to the doctor on call. This includes but is not limited to red eye, painful/hurt eye, injury, or sudden change in vision. Please do not go to urgent care or the emergency room for eye issues. Our doctor on call will be happy to see you.
- **Pick Up Glasses and Contacts:** This will be curbside delivery only. If you need to pick up glasses or contacts please stay in your car and we will deliver them to you. Please call the office when you arrive. OR we can mail these to you at no charge.
Our office will have staff available for pick up between the hours of 9:00-1:00 Monday through Friday.
- **Appointments:** All appointments have been cancelled and moved to our priority list. When we open all of these appointments will receive priority.
- **Contacts:** If you are out of contacts please call the office. We can help!
- **Medications:** If you need a refill on a medication, call our office and we will transmit a refill electronically to your pharmacy.

We will be reviewing this plan on a weekly basis and adjusting based upon CDC recommendations. When we are able to resume normal business, Lowcountry Eye Care will be here to help you “see better to experience life better”.
